## Quran Khawani & Dua For Staff Nurse, Shazia Kamal




## Diabetic Retinopathy Screening Camp

Clinical laboratory plays main role in making diagnosis, tailoring treatment and follow up management. In order to attain reliable test results both Internal and the external quality controls are of paramount significance .esp. participation in external quality assurance programs works as an indicator to gauge regular routine and Retrospective performance of a clinical laboratory. In view of determining a quality performance of Jinnah Medical College Hospital (Shaheed-e-Millat Campus) laboratory, we started External Quality Assessment Schemes (EQAS) to provide improved patient care and safety and first cycle of 12 months from June 2017 July 2018 in department of clinical biochemistry/chemical pathology has been completed. Our results are within acceptable to very good performance ranges (95%-100%). This indicates quality and reliability reports of our laboratory. Good performances provide confidence that patients are providing proper diagnosis and management esp. in critically care services like us where accurate diagnosis is most urgent required.

Dr Mahwash Bizanjo, Consultant Infectious Diseases at JMCH, conducted this two days session for the doctors, nurses & paramedics, she told that "Humans are infected by bite of infected Ixodid ticks or by contact with blood or tissues of viremic patients or animals. This may occur primarily in hospital setting causing

nosocomial spread. The disease is characterized by abrupt onset of fever, headache, fatigue, and myalgia, as well as gastrointestinal symptoms, such as nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea. The prevention and control should be both at community level as well as in hospital set up. Minimizing human contact with suspected livestock and use of unpasteurized dairy products should be discouraged".

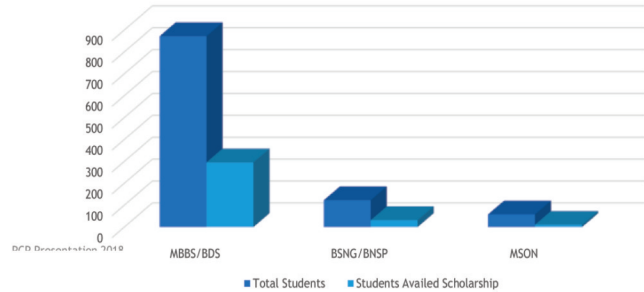

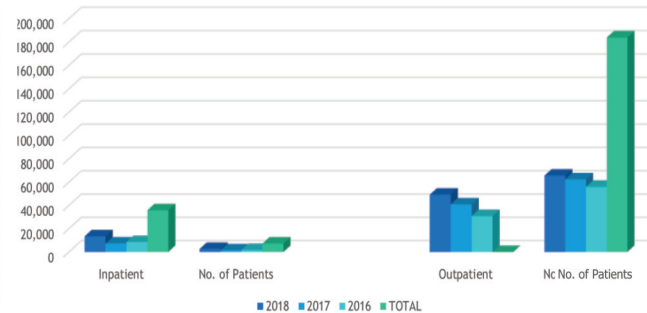
