Q: 1. When does admission start?

A: From August 8th 2021

Q: 2. Who can enroll in nursing Post RN BSN program?

A: Matric with Science (Biology, Chemistry & Physics as compulsory subjects) Or Matric Arts as per HEC Notification No.8 (61)/A&A/2018/HEC/5998 dt. 06.04.2018. Diploma in Nursing, Diploma in Midwifery (any Post Basic Specialty for male in lieu of midwifery, Experience: 01 years as RN, Gender Ratio: Open Merit, qualify the Interview

Q: 3 Who can enroll in nursing Generic BSN program?

A: HSc (Pre-Medical) with 50% marks minimum (Physics, Chemistry & Biology as compulsory subjects) or equal foreign qualification Age Limit: 17-35 years, Gender Ratio: Open for Male and female and Interview

Q: 4. Who can apply?

A: Candidates from all over Pakistan are encouraged to apply.

Q: 5. Can International candidates apply?

A: Yes required A - level or equivalent qualification (IBCC equivalences required)

Q: 6. What is the Generic BSN and Post RN BSN aimed at?

A: The aim of the Nursing degree programs combine knowledge learnt from the physical and behavioral sciences, informatics, and the humanities and nursing theory and implement it into nursing professional practice. Engage the students in discovery of knowledge & develop critical thinking skill to solve the problem, of individual, family, & community and use these research findings for evidence based nursing practice. The curriculum are designed in alignment with local and global health care industry practices which also makes it suitable for students who want to relocate themselves internationally.

A: Generic BSN is 4 years Degree Program (Morning) (8 semesters of 16-18 weeks = 135 credit hours followed by one-year internship)

A: Post RN BSN is 2 Years degree Program (Evening) (4 semesters of 16-18 weeks = 64 credit hours)

Q: 12. What is meant by “Credit hours”?

A: Credit hours represent number of hours a student is required to study in a subject. For example 3 Credit hour class teaching means a student is required to study three hours of a particular subject in a week. For clinical and lab, one credit hour is equal to three hours of a particular subject in a week

Q: 13. How will the programs be taught?

A: At Jinnah College of Nursing, the fundamental pedagogical tool is learning by doing (experiential learning) where students are required to participate actively in all curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and clinical duties at attached hospitals and community health centers. Project and case study methods are the major tools which are supplemented by individual and group exercises, role-plays, problem based learning, simulation exercises, field community visits, lecture-cum discussion by students. Throughout four years of stay at Jinnah College of Nursing, students will actively be participating in conferences, seminars and guest speaker sessions conducted by top notch industry professional in their respective fields. Active participation will allow students to learn from industry experts which will ultimately help students build their career effectively.

Q: 16. What are the application requirements for Post RN BSN?

A: RN, Midwifery or any other specialty in lieu of midwifery and one year experience as RN

Q: 17. Where is Korangi Campus situated?

A: Jinnah Medical College Hospital Korangi Campus Korangi Industrial Area near TCS office Karachi

Q: 18. How to apply at Jinnah College of Nursing Sohail University?

A: Forms are available at admission office of Sohail University at Medicare cardiac & General Hospital Bahadurabad as well as from Jinnah College of Nursing Korangi campus or you can download the admission form website and send with required documents at Jinnah College of Nursing , Jinnah Medical College Hospital Korangi Campus Korangi Industrial Area near TCS office Karachi

Q:19. What is the admission and processing fee?

A: 2000 Admission processing fee will be charged if any student wants to apply more than two programs, 500 extra will be charged for other programs to apply.

Tuition fees are subject to yearly revision depending on inflation and cost of living index

There is Rs. 5,000/- as Security deposit refundable after completion of the degree.

Q:21. What is the refund/cancellation policy? /How do I withdraw from the program and what are the consequences?

A: Students can withdraw from any semester / program but have to pay fee or pay back the scholarship or any other dues till date. Admission and semester fee will not be refunded. However Policies differ depending on the program to which you have been enrolled. Further please visit the Refund and Cancellations Policy of university and HEC.

Q: 22. What is the process for submitting admission and processing fee online?

A: You can download the admission form from Jinnah College of Nursing website <http://www.jcn.edu.pk> & send the form dually filled accompanied with required documents and pay order on the name the Sohail University (AC # 0010005042580269) and send the forms at Jinnah college of Nursing postal address Jinnah Medical College Hospital Korangi Campus Korangi Industrial Area near TCS office Karachi

Q: 23. What is the process of receiving my admit card?

A: You can collect the admit card from Jinnah College of Nursing prior to admission interview. Only out of station candidates can collect their admit cards same day at the time of admission interview on payment of processing fee from secretary college of nursing

Q: 24. What is the process of submitting fee by bank challan?

A: You can submit fee by pay order on the name of Sohail University & directly to account department

Q: 25. What English Language Proficiency tests are required?

A: Proficiency of English will be checked at the time of interview

Q: 26. Can I apply for scholarship?

A: Deserving, meritorious based scholarship is available for female and male candidates. Females are encouraged to apply. Continuity of scholarship depends on the academic performance of students and subject to revise yearly basis

Q: 27. Will be a transport available to pick up & drop the students for a short visit or clinical purpose during the program?

A: Transport will be available for official community visits

Q: 28. When will I receive a fee vouchers for tuition fee & other charges?

A: Students have to pay fee prior to start of new semester except the valid reason. Prior approval from the HOD required prior to deadline otherwise late surcharge will be applicable. Students of Post RN BSN will pay their monthly fee prior to 10th of month.

Q: 29. May I pay fee in lum-sum?

A: Yes

Q: 30. How do I transfer credits into my undergraduate institution?

A: It will not be encouraged except valid reasons; however, students from HEC recognized and PNC accredited institutions will be considered. Official transcript and courses studied with course grid required to evaluate. Only 30% of credit hours can be transferred in one program.

Q:31. Will I need to buy textbooks?

A: We have all reference books for the program. Students are issued the books for specified period of time; however, students are encouraged to buy their own books for their long lasting learning. Faculty members share class schedule, course grid and TOS at the start of course, teaching material at the end of lecture and let them know reference books for their study. It is students' reasonability to use it. Students can take journals and have an online access to learning material
